## 1. Actions and Matters Arising from the Minutes of the Regional AGM on 8 October 2022:

- Facebook advertising for the Windsor Horse Show: Whilst it was still unclear why the problems with the 2022 event had occurred, the Chairman had met the Social Media Manager, Kieran Moggs at the NEC show in October and had discussed the issues. Kieran had confirmed that he was happy to support the 2023 event and the Chairman had already sent him information and approved photographs that could be used on the Facebook pages.
- Costs of the EHU equipment: It had been confirmed that the costs for transporting the EHU equipment
  would again be shared in 2023, with Bucks paying for the transport to Windsor and the costs for
  transferring the equipment to Northamptonshire to be funded by ClubFest.
- **Life Membership:** It was confirmed that Honorary Members had to renew every 3 years, but it was recommended it would be worthwhile checking each year that their Centre membership was still valid.

#### 2. Club Business:

- **Booking Capability:** Went live at the beginning of September quite a few issues to start with, many of which have now been remedied through regular software upgrades.
- Sites:
  - Lady Margaret's Park has reopened after refurbishment
  - Cheddar phase 2 should be completed by end of December
  - Baltic Wharf currently open until end of year as ever, more extensions possible
  - 11 new CLs added to network this year, but offset by 12 closures.

## 3. **Secretary's Report:**

- Rally Search Function: The Secretary reported that she had not received any further feedback but had discovered the search function was now working but only up to the end of December.
